

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 12-11-2017-4

Passed DECEMBER 11 2017

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE  
VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE AND SELL SURPLUS AND  
UNUSED VILLAGE PROPERTY, TO WIT: A MOTOR VEHICLE  
PREVIOUSLY USED BY THE STREET DEPARTMENT,  
AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village owns one (1) surplus motor vehicle previously utilized by the Village Street Department, to wit: a 1996 Chevrolet 3500 dump truck with plow and salt auger, which property needs to be sold at public sale; and,

WHEREAS, the sale of said property will add to the general fund of the Village, be available to the Village Street Department for purchase of new equipment, and eliminate storage issues; and,


WHEREAS, Safety Committee has reviewed the matter and recommends approval of the public sale of this motor vehicle; and,

WHEREAS, this legislation needs to be adopted on an emergency basis due to the need for new equipment by the Street Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF  
THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,  
THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to advertise and sale, at a public sale, surplus and unused miscellaneous Village property, to wit: a 1996 Chevrolet 3500 dump truck with plow and salt auger previously used by the Street Department. A copy of the title to the motor vehicle to be sold is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
