Ordinance No. 2-27-2017-2

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 452.16
OF THE BALTIMORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES (PARKING PROHIBITED ON
CERTAIN STREETS) AND THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP TO PROVIDE FOR
NO PARKING ON A PORTION OF CLIFF STREET, AND
THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Safety Committee has recommended the designation of the south side of Cliff Street from the intersection of Cliff Street and North Main Street east to the intersection of Cliff Street and the first alley immediately east of the intersection of Cliff Street and North Main Street, as a parking prohibited area; and,

WHEREAS, this amendment to the Traffic Control Map needs to be adopted as soon as possible for safety reasons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL
OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY,
OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the south side of Cliff Street from the intersection of Cliff Street and North Main Street east to the intersection of Cliff Street and the first alley immediately east of the intersection of Cliff Street and North Main Street, be designated as a parking prohibited area; and that Section 452.16 of the Baltimore Codified Ordinances (Parking Prohibited on Certain Streets), together with the Traffic Control Map and Traffic Control File, be amended to reflect this parking prohibited designation.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Accordingly, after the designation of the amendment upon the Codified Ordinances, the Traffic Control Map, and in the Traffic Control File, and after the erection of the appropriate signage, this ordinance shall immediately become effective.
