AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2015 APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE IN ORDER TO CREATE A POLICE DEPARTMENT FUND

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend the 2015 Appropriations Ordinance in order to create a new fund titled "Police Department Fund," which shall be maintained separate and apart from the General Fund; and,

WHEREAS, Finance Committee has reviewed the matter and recommends approval of this amendment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL
OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY,
OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: The 2015 Appropriations Ordinance is hereby amended in order to create a new fund titled "Police Department Fund," which shall be maintained separate and apart from the General Fund and shall be known as fund/account number 209-.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest period authorized by law.
