Ordinance No. 2015- 15

AN ORDINANCE TO REDEFINE THE DUTIES OF D.A.R.E. OFFICERS WITHIN THE BALTIMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Village desires to redefine the duties of D.A.R.E. (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) police officers within the Village Police Department, specifically: to limit the role of D.A.R.E. officers to providing two one-week instruction classes per year to the Liberty Union-Thurston School District; and,

WHEREAS, Finance Committee has reviewed the proposed redefinition of duties and approves the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL
OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY,
OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the duties of D.A.R.E. (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) police officers within the Village Police Department shall be limited to providing two one-week instruction classes per year to the Liberty Union-Thurston School District.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest period authorized by law.
