AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF KATHRYN E. JENKINS TO THE POSITION OF VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Village to fill the position of Village Fiscal Officer due to the approaching retirement date of the current Fiscal Officer, Florence D. Welker; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor desires to appoint Kathryn E. Jenkins to fill this position; and,

WHEREAS, Finance Committee has reviewed the matter and recommends the hiring of Kathryn E. Jenkins as Village Fiscal Officer; and,

• WHEREAS, this ordinance needs to be passed on an emergency basis due to the vacancy to be created with the approaching retirement date of the current Fiscal Officer and the need of the Village to maintain the position of Fiscal Officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That the Mayor is authorized and directed to appoint Kathryn E. Jenkins to the position of Village Fiscal Officer. The effective commencement date of the appointment shall be June 29, 2015.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
