Ordinance No. 2015- 44

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 452.16
OF THE BALTIMORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES (PARKING PROHIBITED ON
CERTAIN STREETS) AND THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP TO PROVIDE FOR
NO PARKING ON A PORTION OF WASHINGTON STREET, AND
THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Safety Committee has recommended the designation of the north side of Washington Street from the intersection of Brown Street and Washington Street west to the intersection of Oak Street and Washington Street, as a parking prohibited area; and,

WHEREAS, this amendment to the Traffic Control Map needs to be adopted as soon as possible for safety reasons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL
OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY,
OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the north side of Washington Street from the intersection of Brown Street and Washington Street west to the intersection of Oak Street and Washington Street, be designated as a parking prohibited area; and that Section 452.16 of the Baltimore Codified Ordinances (Parking Prohibited on Certain Streets), together with the Traffic Control Map and Traffic Control File, be amended to reflect this parking prohibited designation.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Accordingly, after the designation of the amendment upon the Codified Ordinances, the Traffic Control Map, and in the Traffic Control File, and after the erection of the appropriate signage, this ordinance shall immediately become effective.
