AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1046 (PARKS) OF THE BALTIMORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village desires to update the rental fees of the shelter houses at Johnson Park and Basil Park, as set forth in Chapter 1046 (PARKS) of the Codified Ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, Service Committee has reviewed the proposed amendments and recommends adoption of the same; and,

WHEREAS, due to the approaching spring and summer seasons, this ordinance needs to be adopted as an emergency in order for the updated rental fees to be in effect in a timely fashion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL
OF VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY,
OHIO, 3/4's (THREE-FOURTH'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That Section 1046.01(a) (PARKS - SHELTER HOUSE AND COMMUNITY CENTER RATES AND RULES FOR USAGE), which currently reads as follows:

“(a) The Johnson Park Shelter House and the Basil Park Community Center shall be available to the public on a rental basis. The rates shall be as follows:

	Resident	Nonresident	Resident	Nonresident
Half Day	\$50	\$75	\$50	\$75
Full Day	\$75	\$100	\$75	\$100”

is hereby amended to read as follows:

“(a) The Johnson Park Shelter House and the Basil Park Community Center shall be available to the public on a rental basis. The rates shall be as follows:

Half Day	\$100	\$125	\$100	\$125
Full Day	\$150	\$225	\$150	\$225”

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
