AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE VILLAGE'S 2018-2019 PAY PLAN AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village desires to adopt the 2018-2019 Pay Plan; and,


WHEREAS, Finance Committee has reviewed the proposed Pay Plan and recommends adoption of the same; and,

WHEREAS, in order for the proposed amendments as set forth in the 2018-2019 Pay Plan to be enacted in a timely fashion, this legislation needs to be adopted as an emergency;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
THREE-FOURTHS' (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village's 2018-2019 Pay Plan is hereby adopted, and Attachment 2 to the Village's 2018-2019 Pay Plan is amended accordingly and a copy of the same is attached hereto.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
