## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, OHIO TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act (AM. Sub. H.B. No. 100), was signed into law on December 4, 1985; and,

WHEREAS, effective March 6, 1986, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act provides the opportunity for counties, townships, municipal corporations, regional transit authorities, regional airport authorities or port authorities and school districts, conservancy districts, township park districts and park districts and other authorities, to participate in contracts distributed by the state of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Baltimore, Ohio desires to avail itself of the Act in order to realize financial savings, and further desires that this resolution be passed on an emergency basis so that the Village can realize financial savings as soon as possible;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF  
THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,  
THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village Administrator hereby requests authority in the name of the Village of Baltimore, Ohio, to participate in state contracts which the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing has entered into and the Office of Cooperative Purchasing has distributed for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain other materials pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04.

SECTION 2: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Village of Baltimore, Ohio to be bound by all contract terms and conditions as the Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing prescribes. Such terms and conditions may include a reasonable annual membership fee to cover the administrative costs which the Department of Administrative Services incurs as a result of the Village of Baltimore, Ohio's participation in the contract. Further, that the Village Administrator does hereby agree to be bound by all such terms and conditions and to not cause or assist in any way the misuse of such contracts or make contract disclosures to non-members of the Coop for the purpose of avoiding the requirements established by ORC Section 125.04.

SECTION 3: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Village of Baltimore, Ohio to directly pay the vendor, under each such state contract in which it participates for items it receives pursuant to the contract, and the Village Administrator does hereby agree to directly pay the vendor.

SECTION 4: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. This resolution shall become effective upon its passage by Council.

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
