A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE PARK FUND IN COMPLIANCE WITH REQUIREMENTS OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES NATURE-WORKS GRANT PROGRAM, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, has awarded the Village of Baltimore a grant through the NatureWorks Grant Program; and,

WHEREAS, the Village is required to advance funds from the General Fund to the Park Fund in order to pay for the equipment before reimbursement is received from the State of Ohio through the grant funding; and,

WHEREAS, this legislation needs to be passed on an emergency basis in order to timely comply with the grant requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village of Baltimore authorizes the transfer of funds in the amount of \$15,000.00 from the General Fund (1001) to the Park Fund (2041), in order to pay for equipment until grant funds are received from the State of Ohio.

SECTION 2: That upon the receipt of the grant funds from the State of Ohio, the amount of \$15,000.00 shall be reimbursed to the General Fund.

SECTION 3: That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare. Therefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
