Ordinance No. 2018- 18

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH RUMPKE WASTE & RECYCLING SERVICES, INC., FOR RESIDENTIAL WASTE REFUSE REMOVAL AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village has previously entered into a contract with Rumpke Waste & Recycling Services Inc. for the collection, transportation, and disposal of garbage and refuse of residential households of the Village of Baltimore; and,

WHEREAS, the original bid specifications provide that the contract may be extended for up to five additional one (1) year terms; and,


WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has reviewed the matter and recommends the approval of a contract extension with Rumpke Waste & Recycling Services Inc., as set forth in the original bid specifications; and,

WHEREAS, due to the upcoming expiration of the Village's current contract for garbage and refuse removal services, and the Village's need to assure its residents that garbage and refuse removal will continue uninterrupted, this ordinance will need to be passed on an emergency basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:


SECTION 1: That the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract extension with Rumpke Waste & Recycling Services Inc. for the purpose of granting an exclusive license for garbage and refuse collection of residential households of the Village of Baltimore, Ohio, from July 1, 2018 to December 31, 2022. A copy of the extension terms and all relevant documents related thereto, are attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.

Hi Teri,

I wanted to notify you that Pickerington passed a 5-year extension with Rumpke at a recent council meeting, we've provided them with the final documents and we expect to receive a signed addendum next week. Once that's in hand, I'll be able to reach out to you with an official offer. For now, a summary is below and I'm happy to explain it in person or by phone next week at your convenience. Enjoy your weekend!

In Summary:

- **Services/Terms:** Service offerings will remain unchanged. However, if you'd like us to offer only weekly recycling with a 65-gallon carts as opposed to weekly *and* every other weekly recycling, and 35-gallon cart and bin options, we should be able to accommodate. Everything else will continue, based on the 1/1/12 – 12/31/17 contract.
- **Pricing/Adjustments:** The annual CPI increase will be dissolved. Instead, we've preset the annual adjustment (shown below). The only adjustment made to the rates below will be a quarterly fuel adjustment based on Rumpke's Fuel Table.
