
## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018 APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL  
OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY,  
OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: The following amendments are hereby made to the 2018 Appropriations Ordinance:

- ▶ To increase the General Fund appropriations, Police OPERS line item (1000-110-211), by \$5,000.00;
- ▶ To increase the General Fund appropriations, Council Salaries line item (1000-715-111), by \$950.00;
- ▶ To increase the General Fund appropriations, Council OPERS line item (1000-715-211), by \$150.00;
- ▶ To increase the General Fund appropriations, Council Medicare line item (1000-715-213), by \$20.00;
- ▶ To increase the Permissive Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund, Streets, Highways, Sidewalks & Curbs line item (2101-800-555), by \$18,000.00;
- ▶ To increase the Water Fund, Natural Gas line item (5101-534-313), by \$1,000.00;

SECTION 2: As the above appropriation changes need to be in effect as soon as possible, this ordinance shall be adopted as an emergency.
