**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 830 OF THE
BALTIMORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES (MUNICIPAL INCOME
TAX) IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR A REALLOCATION OF FUNDS
AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend Codified Ordinance Chapter 830 (Municipal Income Tax) in order to provide for a reallocation of funds, as recommended by the Village Fiscal Officer, retroactive to January 1, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, Finance Committee has reviewed the suggested reallocation and recommends approval of the same; and

WHEREAS, due to the need of the Village to continue to meet its various financial obligations, and to establish the effective date of the reallocation, this ordinance needs to be approved on an emergency basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That Section 830.13 (ALLOCATION OF FUNDS), which currently reads in relevant part as follows:

“(a) The funds collected under the provisions of this chapter shall be applied for the following purposes, to wit:

(2) The balance of the funds collected under the provisions of this chapter shall be paid into special funds which are hereby established for the following purposes:

A. 100% to the General Fund for any legal operating expense;”

is hereby amended to read as follows:

“(a) The funds collected under the provisions of this chapter shall be applied for the following purposes, retroactive to January 1, 2017, to wit:

(2) The balance of the funds collected each year under the provisions of this chapter shall be paid into special funds which are hereby established for the following purposes:

A. 52% to the General Fund for any legal operating expense;

B. 43% to the Street Fund for any legal operating expense; and,

C. 5% to the Swimming Pool Fund for any legal operating expense;”

SECTION 2: All other provisions of Chapter 830 of the Baltimore Codified Ordinances, not specifically amended herein, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
