Ordinance No. 2018- 33

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STRAWSER PAVING COMPANY, INC., FOR THE DORCHESTER DR., CIRCLE DR. & TREMONT CT. RESURFACING PROJECT AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village requested bids for the Dorchester Dr., Circle Dr. & Tremont Ct. Resurfacing Project, an Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) project; and,

WHEREAS, Strawser Paving Company, Inc., has submitted the best and lowest bid for the project; and,

WHEREAS, Bird+Bull, Engineers & Surveyors, and Safety Committee of Council have recommended that the Village award the contract to Strawser Paving Company, Inc., for construction of the project; and,

WHEREAS, this ordinance needs to be passed on an emergency basis so that the Village can complete the project prior to the termination of the asphalt production season;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Strawser Paving Company, Inc., for the Dorchester Dr., Circle Dr. & Tremont Ct. Resurfacing Project in an amount not to exceed \$410,193.00. A copy of the bid from Strawser Paving Company, Inc., shall be attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the community. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council.
