Ordinance No. 2018-48

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL  
MAP TO ERECT "NO THRU TRUCKS" SIGNS  
THROUGHOUT THE VILLAGE WITH THE EXCEPTION OF  
MAIN STREET, MARKET STREET AND A PORTION OF WATER STREET**

WHEREAS, the Village desires to erect "No Thru Trucks" signs throughout the Village with the exception of Main Street, Market Street and a portion of Water Street, due to the fact that the Village streets are too narrow for trucks to safely navigate the same; and,

WHEREAS, Safety Committee has reviewed the matter and recommends the erection of "No Thru Trucks" signs at said intersections;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL  
OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY,  
OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village's Traffic Control Map is hereby amended to provide for the following:

To erect "No Thru Trucks" signs throughout the Village with the exception of Main Street, Market Street, and the portion of Water Street from the intersection of Water Street and Main Street to the intersection of Water Street and Washington Street.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest time authorized by law after the erection of the necessary signage and after the appropriate designations on the traffic control map.
