AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018 APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL
OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY,
OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: The following amendments are hereby made to the 2018 Appropriations Ordinance:

- To reduce the Permissive Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund appropriations (2101), Capital Outlay line item (2101-800-500), by \$116,515.00; and
- To reduce the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) Fund appropriations (4901), Capital Outlay line item (4901-800-500), by the amount not distributed by OPWC by December 31, 2018, not to exceed \$349,548.00;

SECTION 2: As the above appropriation changes need to be in effect as soon as possible, this ordinance shall be adopted as an emergency.
