**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER
1026 OF THE BALTIMORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES (WATER AND
WASTEWATER RULES AND REGULATIONS) IN ORDER
TO UPDATE SPECIAL PROVISIONS**

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend the Water and Wastewater Rules and Regulations as set forth in Chapter 1026, in order to update Section XI - Special Provisions; and,

WHEREAS, Rules Committee has reviewed the proposed amendment and recommends adoption of the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL
OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY,
OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:


SECTION 1: That "Section XI - Special Provisions" of Chapter 1026 of the Baltimore Codified Ordinances (Water and Wastewater Rules & Regulations), is hereby amended to include the following new provision:

"Section XI - Special Provisions

Use of Public Sewers - General Regulations

No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any storm water, surface water, ground water, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, cooling water or unpolluted industrial process waters to any sanitary sewer. No person shall discharge to any natural outlet within the Village of Baltimore, or in any area under the jurisdiction of said Village, any sewage or other polluted water, except where suitable treatment had been provided in accordance with subsequent provisions these rules and regulations. No unauthorized person shall uncover, make any connections with, or opening into, use, alter, or disturb any public sewer or appurtenance thereof without first obtaining a written permit from the Village of Baltimore Administrator. All disposal by any person into the sewer system is unlawful except those discharges in compliance with Federal or State standards and if applicable more stringent local standards."

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest time period provided for by law.
