AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES FOR THE BALTIMORE SWIMMING POOL FOR THE 2019 SEASON AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village needs to establish rates for the Baltimore swimming pool, in advance of the opening of the swimming pool for the 2019 season; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance needs to be passed as an emergency since the rates need to be in place prior to the start of membership sales for the 2019 swim season;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the 2019 fees for the Baltimore Swimming Pool are as follows:

DAILY RATES FOR ENTIRE DAY:

- Ages 3 and under Free
- Ages 4 to 59 \$7.00
- Ages 60 and over \$4.00
- Daycare \$4.00

DAILY RATES FROM 4:00 P.M. TO CLOSING:

- Ages 3 and under Free
- Ages 4 to 59 \$4.00
- Ages 60 and over \$3.00

MEMBERSHIP RATES:

- Single - Village Resident \$100.00
- Single - Village Non-Resident \$160.00
- Family - Village Resident (up to six Users in same household) \$225.00
- Family - Village Resident (for each User in same household, in excess of six Users) \$ 20.00
- Family - Village Non-Resident (up to six Users in same household) \$275.00
- Family - Village Non-Resident (for each User in same household, in excess of six Users) \$ 20.00
- Babysitter (with Family pass) \$ 20.00

MEMBERSHIP RATES FOR WEEKENDS AND AFTER 4:00 P.M. WEEKDAYS:

- Family - Village Resident (up to six Users in same household) \$125.00
- Family - Village Non-Resident (up to six Users in same household) \$175.00

OTHER RATES:

- Swim Lessons Resident: \$30.00 Non-Resident: \$40.00
- Pool Rental \$175.00, up to 50 people; \$25.00 for each additional 50 people, or less;
- Pool Rental for Swim Team Meets \$175.00 per meet
- Swim Team Members who are not Village Pool Members \$25.00 per season
