**AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING SECTION
660.07 OF THE GENERAL OFFENSES CODE
(SAFETY, SANITATION AND HEALTH - STORAGE OF JUNK VEHICLES)
OF THE VILLAGE'S CODIFIED ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, the Village has previously adopted the International Property Maintenance Code (IPMC), which Code addresses the storage of junk vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, due to the adoption of the IPMC, the current provisions set forth in Chapter 660.07 (General Offenses Code - Safety, Sanitation and Health - Storage of Junk Vehicles) of the Village's codified ordinances are redundant and unnecessary, and can therefore be deleted; and,

WHEREAS, Rules Committee has reviewed the matter and recommends adoption of this legislation;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL
OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY,
OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:**

SECTION 1: Section 660.07 of the General Offenses Code, titled "Safety, Sanitation and Health - Storage of Junk Vehicles," is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest period authorized by law.
