**AN ORDINANCE TO RESCIND ORDINANCE 2018-19 [AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 8 (BUSINESS REGULATION AND TAXATION CODE) OF THE BALTIMORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES IN ORDER TO ADOPT REGULATIONS REGARDING RENTAL DWELLING AND HOUSING PERMITS], AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village previously adopted Ordinance 2018-19 [An Ordinance to Amend Title 8 (Business Regulation and Taxation Code) of the Baltimore Codified Ordinances in Order to Adopt Regulations Regarding Rental Dwelling and Housing Permits]; and,


WHEREAS, the Village desires to rescind Ordinance 2018-19 in its entirety, in order to review the regulations anew; and,

WHEREAS, this legislation needs to be approved on an emergency basis since the regulations set forth in Ordinance 2018-19 have an effective enforcement date of May 12, 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTHS' (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance 2018-19 [An Ordinance to Amend Title 8 (Business Regulation and Taxation Code) of the Baltimore Codified Ordinances in Order to Adopt Regulations Regarding Rental Dwelling and Housing Permits] is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
