Ordinance No. 2019- 21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BIRD+BULL ENGINEERS & SURVEYORS FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE SOUTH MAIN STREET WATERLINE PROJECT, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Baltimore requires specific engineering services (preparation of bid documents) for the South Main Street Waterline Project (“the Project”); and,

WHEREAS, Bird+Bull Engineers & Surveyors has the necessary qualifications to provide such specific engineering services to the Village for the Project; and,

WHEREAS, Finance Committee has reviewed the matter and recommends approval of an agreement between the Village and Bird+Bull Engineers & Surveyors for the provision of specific engineering services for the Project; and,

WHEREAS, this legislation needs to be approved on an emergency basis in order for both the engineering services and bidding process to be completed in a timely fashion, so that the project can be completed prior to the commencement of school;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTH’S (3/4’S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Bird+Bull Engineers & Surveyors in order to provide engineering services to the Village for the South Main Street Waterline Project. The company shall be paid in accordance with its hourly fee schedule previously submitted to the Village.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the community. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council.
