A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD NOVEMBER 5, 2019, AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2015-40, PASSED NOVEMBER 9, 2015 AND EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2016, SO AS TO INCREASE THE BALTIMORE INCOME TAX FROM A RATE OF ONE PERCENT (1%) TO A RATE OF ONE AND ONE-HALF (1 ½ %) PERCENT

WHEREAS, Section 718.04 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that "No municipal corporation shall levy a tax on income at a rate in excess of one percent without having obtained the approval of the excess by a majority of the electors of the municipality voting on the questions at a general, primary or special election;" and,

WHEREAS, in order to maintain Baltimore as a community where people want to live and businesses want to locate and remain a safe community; and,

WHEREAS, safety in our community must continue to be a priority and police protection and keeping a police presence in our schools is and will continue to be critical for Baltimore; and,

WHEREAS, in order to maintain our community as a place where people want to live and businesses want to locate, we must fix our aging streets which also aids in maintaining property values and preserve the community expected quality of life services and programming;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: Pursuant Section 718.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Village Of Baltimore hereby requests and directs that the Fairfield County Board of Elections place before the voters of the Village of Baltimore on the November 5, 2019 general election ballot, ORDINANCE 2019-23, which proposes to increase the municipal income tax rate from its current one percent (1%) to one and one-half percent (1½ %), said Ordinance being attached hereto as EXHIBIT A.

SECTION 2: That this amendment be digested on the voting machine with the following language subject to approval by the Fairfield County Board of Elections:

"Shall Ordinance 2019-23, providing for an additional one-half percent (½ %) levy on income earned on or after January 1, 2020, such that the total rate levied on income earned per annum shall equal one and one-half percent (1½ %), and providing that the revenue resulting therefrom be dedicated for the purpose of funding the operations of Village, including, without limitation, streets, parks, public safety, or capital improvements, be passed?"

SECTION 3: The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to timely submit this Ordinance to the Fairfield County Board of Elections, before 4:00 PM on August 7, 2019, for placement on the November 5, 2019 General Election Ballot for consideration by the Village of Baltimore electorate.


