AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO CONTRACT WITH COUGHLIN MOTOR SALES AND FAIRFIELD NATIONAL BANK OR FORD CREDIT MUNICIPAL FINANCE FOR THE LEASE-PURCHASE OF A 2019 FORD F550 SERVICE TRUCK WITH SNOW PLOW PACKAGE AND CRANE ATTACHMENT, FOR THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Service Department is in need of a new service truck with snow plow package and crane attachment for the efficient operation of its department; and,

WHEREAS, Fairfield National Bank of Baltimore, Ohio, has committed to financing the purchase of this vehicle by the Village, pursuant to a commercial loan proposal; in addition, Ford Credit Municipal Finance has committed to finance the lease-purchase of this vehicle by the Village, pursuant to a commercial lease-purchase proposal; and,

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 735.051 further authorizes the purchase of supplies or materials without formal bidding and advertising in the event of a real and present emergency; and,

WHEREAS, Service Committee has recommended the purchase, and approved the appropriation of funds for the purchase; and,

WHEREAS, although the Village has been given the opportunity to “piggy-back” with the State of Ohio, the Village has also determined that the estimated replacement cost obtained by the Village for a new truck (\$119,250.00) from Coughlin Motor Sales, is less than the estimated cost provided by the State of Ohio through its piggy-back bidding process for a comparable new vehicle (\$133,000.00); and,

WHEREAS, due to the recent failure of operation of the Village’s current service truck, the advanced age of the service truck (17 years), the high estimated cost to repair the same, and the Village’s reliance on the service truck on a daily basis, a real and present emergency exists for the operation and maintenance of the Service Department, and as a result this ordinance will need to be passed on an emergency basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTH’S (3/4’S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: The Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Coughlin Motor Sales for the purchase of a 2019 Ford F550 service truck with snow plow package and crane attachment, for an amount not to exceed \$120,000.00, without competitive bidding or advertising as authorized per Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code. A copy of the purchase proposal from Coughlin Motor Sales shall be attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: The Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into either: 1) a commercial loan agreement with Fairfield National Bank of Baltimore, Ohio, for the financing of the purchase of the above vehicle, for a loan amount not exceeding \$120,000.00 and an interest rate not exceeding 2.5% APR; or: 2) a lease-purchase agreement with Ford Credit Municipal Finance, for an amount not exceeding \$120,000.00 and an interest rate not exceeding 7.5% APR. A copy of the commercial loan commitment from Fairfield National Bank and Ford Credit Municipal Finance shall be attached hereto and incorporated herein.
