AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019 APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL
OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY,
OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: The following amendments are hereby made to the 2019 Appropriations Ordinance:

- ◆ To increase the General Fund appropriations, Security of Persons & Property, Employee Benefits, line item (1000-110), by \$4,600.00;
- ◆ To increase the General Fund appropriations, General Government, Employee Benefits, line item (1000-725), by \$4,600.00;

SECTION 2: As the above appropriation changes need to be in effect as soon as possible, with an effective retroactive date to October 1, 2019, this ordinance shall be adopted as an emergency.
