**AN ORDINANCE TO SUSPEND THE INCREASES IN SALARIES OF THE  
MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE 2018-10  
ADOPTED ON MARCH 26, 2018, AND THE  
DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village desires to suspend the increases in salaries of the positions of Village Mayor and Village Council, which increases were authorized by Ordinance 2018-10 adopted on March 26, 2018; and,


WHEREAS, the Village desires to suspend the increases for a period of four (4) years from January 1, 2020;

WHEREAS, in order for the proposed suspension to be effective as of January 1, 2020, this legislation needs to be adopted as an emergency;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF  
THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,  
THREE-FOURTHS' (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the increases in salaries of the positions of Village Mayor and Village Council, which increases were authorized by Ordinance 2018-10 adopted on March 26, 2018, are hereby suspended effective January 1, 2020, for a period of four (4) years.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
