**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL
MAP TO ERECT "NO SEMITRAILERS" SIGNS
ON A PORTION OF WATER STREET,
AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village desires to erect "No Semitrailers" signs on Water Street at the bridge, and the portion of Water Street from the intersection of Water Street and Market Street to the intersection of Water Street and Washington Street, due to the fact that Water Street is too narrow for trucks to safely navigate the same at the bridge; and,

WHEREAS, due to ongoing and immediate safety concerns regarding commercial truck traffic at the bridge on Water Street, this ordinance needs to be passed as an emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL
OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO
THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village's Traffic Control Map is hereby amended to provide for the following:


To erect "No Semitrailers" signs on Water Street at the bridge, and the portion of Water Street from the intersection of Water Street and Market Street to the intersection of Water Street and Washington Street.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the community. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council and after the erection of the necessary signage and appropriate designations on the traffic control map.
