AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 830 OF THE BALTIMORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES (MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX) IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR A REALLOCATION OF FUNDS, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend Codified Ordinance Chapter 830.28 (Municipal Income Tax - Allocation of Funds) in order to provide for a reallocation of funds on a temporary, emergency basis; and,

WHEREAS, in order for the reallocation to be effective immediately, this ordinance needs to be approved on an emergency basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the "ALLOCATION OF FUNDS" set forth in Chapter 830.28, and which currently reads as follows:

"830.28 ALLOCATION OF FUNDS.

- (a) The funds collected under the provisions of this chapter shall be applied for the following purposes, to wit:
- (1) Such part thereof as shall be necessary to defray all costs of collecting the taxes levied by this chapter and the cost of administering and enforcing the provisions thereof.
 - (2) The balance of the funds collected each year under the provisions of this chapter shall be paid into special funds which are hereby established for the following purposes, through December 31, 2018:
 - A. 57% to the General Fund for any legal operating expense;
 - B. 43% to the Street Fund for any legal operating expense;
 - (3) Effective January 1, 2019 and thereafter, the balance of the funds collected each year under the provisions of this chapter shall be paid into special funds which are hereby established for the following purposes:
 - A. 54% to the General Fund for any legal operating expense;
 - B. 43% to the Street Fund for any legal operating expense; and,
 - C. 3% to the Swimming Pool Fund for any legal operating expense;
- (b) Council shall, by ordinance, appropriate the above monies after transfer into the specified funds and allocate such monies in accordance with the needs of the Village of Baltimore. Council may, if and when necessary, appropriate monies from any or all of such special funds for poor relief, public disaster or civil emergency, but in no event shall such appropriation exceed the actual need for such funds."

is hereby amended to read as follows:

"830.28 ALLOCATION OF FUNDS.

- (a) The funds collected under the provisions of this chapter shall be applied for the following purposes, to wit:
- (1) Such part thereof as shall be necessary to defray all costs of collecting the taxes levied by this chapter and the cost of administering and enforcing the provisions thereof.

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- (2) Effective immediately upon the adoption of this ordinance, and through December 31, 2020, the balance of the funds collected each year under the provisions of this chapter shall be paid into special funds which are hereby established for the following purposes:
- A. 100% to the General Fund for any legal operating expense;

Effective January 1, 2021 and thereafter, the balance of the funds collected each year under the provisions of this chapter shall be paid into special funds which are hereby established for the following purposes:

- A. 54% to the General Fund for any legal operating expense;
- B. 43% to the Street Fund for any legal operating expense; and,
- C. 3% to the Swimming Pool Fund for any legal operating expense;

- (b) Council shall, by ordinance, appropriate the above monies after transfer into the specified funds and allocate such monies in accordance with the needs of the Village of Baltimore. Council may, if and when necessary, appropriate monies from any or all of such special funds for poor relief, public disaster or civil emergency, but in no event shall such appropriation exceed the actual need for such funds.”

SECTION 2: All other provisions of Chapter 830 of the Baltimore Codified Ordinances, not specifically amended herein, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
