Ordinance No. 2020- 13

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE SHELLY COMPANY FOR THE REPAVING OF CERTAIN VILLAGE ROADWAYS AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village solicited bids for the repaving of certain Village roadways pursuant to the Village of Baltimore 2020 Roadway Resurfacing Project (Holder Road); and,

WHEREAS, The Shelly Company was determined by the Village Administrator and Council to be the lowest and best bid; and,

WHEREAS, Finance Committee has recommended approval of the contract to The Shelly Company; and,

WHEREAS, in order to complete the repaving project within fair weather months, this measure must be passed as an emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are authorized to enter into a contract with The Shelly Company for the repaving of certain Village roadways pursuant to the Village of Baltimore 2020 Roadway Resurfacing Project (Holder Road), at a base bid price not to exceed \$78,998.10. A copy of the contract shall be attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.


