AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 452.20 (HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES) OF THE BALTIMORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES, AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village desires to erect a handicapped parking sign at 227 N. Yencer Street; and,

WHEREAS, Safety Committee has recommended the placement of the appropriate sign at the above location; and

WHEREAS, in order to have the appropriate sign erected in a timely fashion and in accordance with Ohio laws, this ordinance will need to be passed on an emergency basis;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That Section 452.20 (Handicapped Parking Spaces) be amended to add the following handicapped parking space and sign:

452.20 HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES.

“One space at 227 N. Yencer Street. In the event that the handicapped parking space is no longer needed, the handicapped parking space sign shall be immediately removed.”

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council, after the erection of the necessary signage, and after the appropriate designations on the traffic control map.
