Ordinance No. 2020-26

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ENHANCED FINES FOR A VIOLATION OF THE "NO SEMITRAILERS" ORDINANCE (2020-02) ON A PORTION OF WATER STREET, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village previously adopted Ordinance 2020-02 (An Ordinance Amending the Traffic Control Map to erect "No Semitrailers" Signs on a Portion of Water Street and the Declaration of an Emergency), due to the fact that Water Street is too narrow for trucks to safely navigate the same at the bridge; and,

WHEREAS, the Village desires to establish enhanced fines for a violation of the above "No Semitrailers" ordinance, due to the extensive damage caused to this portion of Water Street, and the subsequent expensive costs to complete needed repairs; and,

WHEREAS, due to ongoing and immediate safety concerns regarding commercial truck traffic at the bridge on Water Street, this ordinance needs to be passed as an emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village hereby establishes the following, enhanced fines for a violation of the provisions set forth in Ordinance 2020-02:


- ◆ A fine of \$100.00 for the first violation of this ordinance;
- ◆ A fine of \$250.00 for the second violation of this ordinance in a one-year period;
- ◆ A fine of \$500.00 for the third and each subsequent violation of this ordinance in a one-year period;

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the community. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council and after the erection of the necessary signage and appropriate designations on the traffic control map.
