

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 5-23-2016-2

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 452.16  
OF THE BALTIMORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND  
THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP TO PROVIDE FOR NO COMMERCIAL  
OR HEAVY VEHICLE PARKING ON A SECTION OF THE SOUTH SIDE  
OF WATER STREET AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Safety Committee has recommended the prohibition of parking of commercial or heavy vehicles on the south side of Water Street from Washington Street to North Main Street, and the placement of appropriate "No Commercial or Heavy Vehicle Parking" and "Tow Away Zone" signage; and,

WHEREAS, this ordinance needs to be passed on an emergency basis for traffic control and safety purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL  
OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY,  
OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That commercial and/or heavy vehicle parking is hereby prohibited on the south side of Water Street from Washington Street to North Main Street, and the placement of appropriate "No Commercial or Heavy Vehicle Parking" and "Tow Away Zone" signage, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: After the designation of the amendment upon the Traffic Control Map and in the Traffic Control File, and for the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio, and shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
