A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE 2018 TAX BUDGET AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.28, Ohio Revised Code, the Baltimore Village Council must adopt a Tax Budget for the 2018 fiscal year prior to July 15, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, the Village has filed, for public inspection, two (2) copies of the proposed Budget in the office of the Fiscal Officer and provided public notice of a hearing on the Tax Budget by the Lancaster Eagle Gazette at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing on the Tax Budget; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the Tax Budget as required by Section 5705.30, Ohio Revised Code, on July 10, 2017, at ~~7:15~~ 8:22 P.M.; and,


WHEREAS, since a copy of the Tax Budget needs to be forwarded to the County Auditor before July 15, 2017, this ordinance needs to be passed as an emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: The 2018 Tax Budget for the Village of Baltimore, Ohio, is hereby adopted. A copy of said Budget is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: The Fiscal Officer is directed to submit two (2) copies of the 2018 Baltimore Tax Budget to the Fairfield County Auditor on or before July 15, 2015.

SECTION 3: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this resolution is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council.
