Ordinance No. 8-14-2017-3

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT AMENDED JOB DESCRIPTIONS (POSITION DESCRIPTIONS) FOR THE POSITIONS OF OPERATOR OF RECORD FOR BOTH THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend the "Position Descriptions" for the positions of Operator of Record for both the Water Treatment Plant and the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and,

WHEREAS, Rules Committee has reviewed the proposed amendments to the position descriptions and recommends approval of the same; and,

WHEREAS, in order for the above employees to promptly and timely understand the duties in their respective positions, this ordinance will need to be passed on an emergency basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village adopts an amended "Position Description" for the positions of Operator of Record for both the Water Treatment Plant and the Wastewater Treatment Plant, and the Appendices to the Employee Manual of Personnel Policies and Regulations are hereby amended to reflect the same. A copy of the amended Position Descriptions for such positions shall be attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
