A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE VILLAGE'S INTENT TO SELL SURPLUS VILLAGE PROPERTY BY INTERNET AUCTION, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village desires to utilize internet auction in order to sell surplus Village property (property that is obsolete, unfit for the use for which it was acquired, or no longer needed for public use); and,


WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code authorizes municipalities to sell such surplus property by internet auction, and requires the municipalities to adopt, each calendar year, legislation authorizing the use of internet auction for the liquidating surplus property, and,

WHEREAS, this legislation needs to be passed on an emergency basis in order for currently surplus property to be sold in a timely fashion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to sell surplus Village property by internet auction, upon the terms and conditions set forth in the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this resolution is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council.
