AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP TO MAKE A PORTION OF THE MARKET STREET AND BASIL STREET INTERSECTION "NO RIGHT TURN ON RED" DURING CERTAIN TIME PERIODS

WHEREAS, Safety Committee has made a recommendation to Council to make a portion of the intersection of Market Street and Basil Street "NO RIGHT TURN ON RED" during certain time periods;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: The Village's Traffic Control Map is hereby amended to provide for the following:

To post a "NO RIGHT TURN ON RED" sign at the intersection of Market Street and Basil Street, for traffic traveling north on Basil Street to east on Market Street Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.;

To post a "NO RIGHT TURN ON RED" sign at the intersection of Market Street and Basil Street, for traffic traveling east on Market Street to south on Basil Street, Monday through Friday from 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.;

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest time authorized by law after the erection of the necessary signage and after the appropriate designations on the traffic control map.
