**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 452
OF THE BALTIMORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
(PARKING - PENALTY) TO ESTABLISH A MINIMUM FINE
AND PAYMENT METHOD FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend Chapter 452 of the Baltimore Codified Ordinances (Parking) in order to establish a minimum fine and payment method for parking violations; and,

WHEREAS, Rules Committee has reviewed and recommended these amendments; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL
OF VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That Section 452.99 (Parking - Penalty) of the Codified Ordinances, which currently reads as follows:

“452.99 PENALTY.

(Editor’s note: See Sections 408.01 and 408.02 for general Traffic Code penalty if no specific penalty is provided.)


is hereby amended to read as follows:

“452.99 PENALTY.

Unless otherwise specifically set forth herein, the minimum penalty for a parking violation shall be \$25.00 plus court costs, and said fine and costs may be paid in advance of any initial court appearance, thereby avoiding the need for the recipient of the parking violation to personally appear in court.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest period authorized by law.
