Ordinance No. 2021-08

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FROM THE SEWER FUND TO COVALEN, INC., FOR A GRINDER PUMP AND ACCESSORIES, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village has purchased a grinder pump and accessories from Covalen, Inc., of Indianapolis, Indiana, for Holder Road improvements; and,

WHEREAS, as the above contractor has already provided the grinder pump and accessories to the Village, and submitted an invoice for the same, this ordinance needs to be approved on an emergency basis in order for the Village to make timely payment to the contractor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Fiscal Officer is authorized and instructed to make payment to Covalen, Inc., of Indianapolis, Indiana, from the Sewer Fund (5201), in the amount of \$5,472.00, for the purchase of a grinder pump and accessories. The authorization is effective to the date of purchase of the equipment.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
