A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE'S PARTICIPATION IN THE GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS FOR THE OHIO WATER AND WASTEWATER INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT PROGRAM, TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Grant provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements in order to improve access to clean drinking water and wastewater infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Baltimore, Fairfield County, Ohio is planning to make capital improvements which include the West Washington Street Waterline Improvement Project and the Inflow & Infiltration Remediation Design Project; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements hereinabove described are considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Grant program; and

WHEREAS, this legislation needs to be adopted on an emergency basis in order to meet any deadlines to submit the grant application and execute contracts, as may be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized on behalf of the Village to apply to the Ohio Department of Development for grant funds as described above.

SECTION 2: That the Village Administrator authorized on behalf of the Village to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining the grant assistance set forth herein.

SECTION 3: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this resolution is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council.

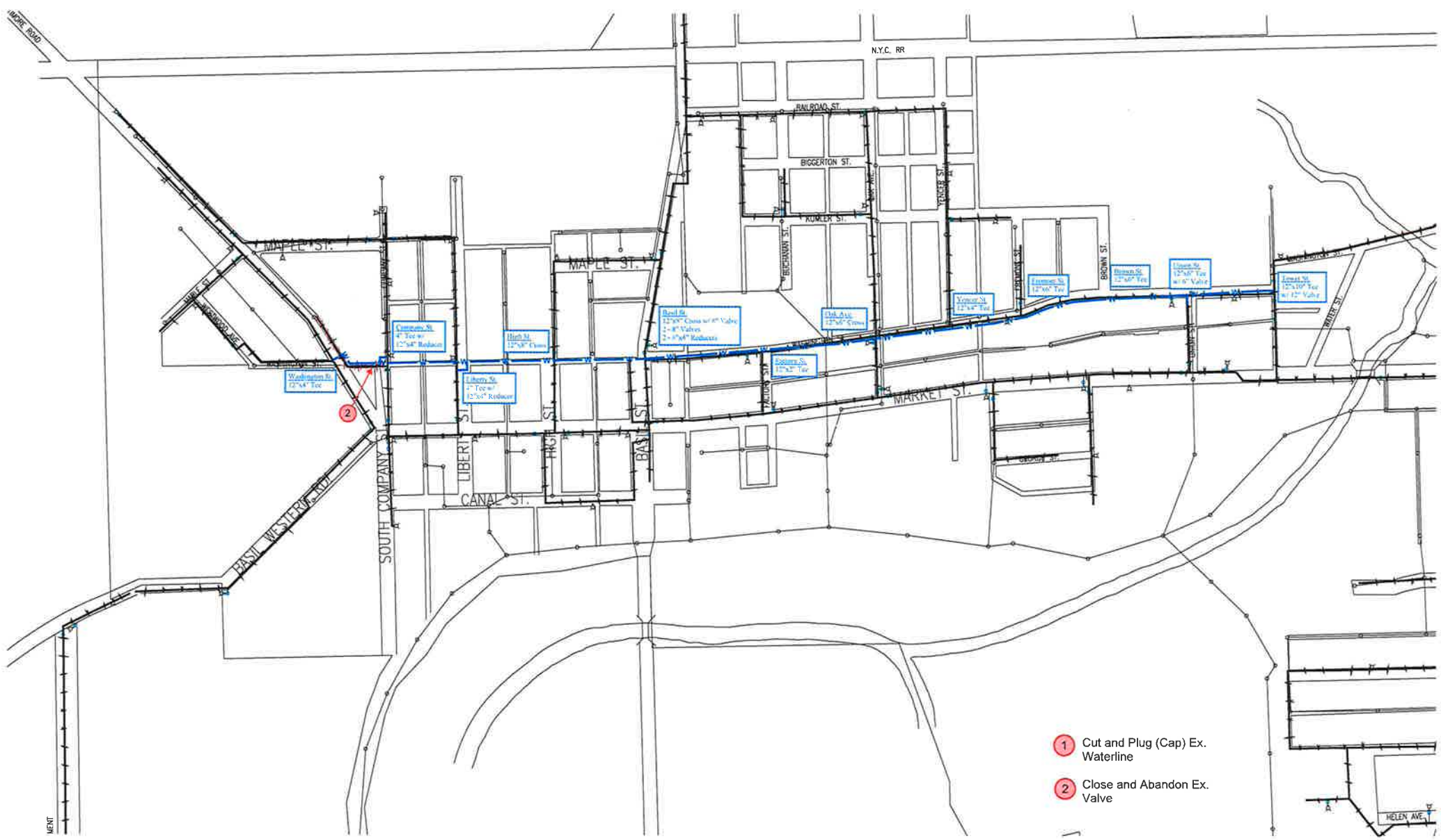
