**AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 2014-32
(AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP
TO CONVERT CANAL STREET TO A ONE-WAY STREET
RUNNING EAST FROM HIGH STREET TO BASIL STREET)**

WHEREAS, the Village previously adopted, on October 27, 2014, Ordinance 2014-32, An Ordinance Amending the Traffic Control Map to Convert Canal Street to a One-Way Street Running East from High Street to Basil Street; and,


WHEREAS, Safety Committee has reviewed the matter and recommends that Ordinance 2014-32 be rescinded in order to allow the above portion of Canal Street to be a two-way street;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: Ordinance 2014-32 is hereby rescinded in its entirety. Therefore, the Village's Traffic Control Map is hereby amended to provide for the following:

Canal Street will become two-way running East from High Street to Basil Street.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest time authorized by law after the erection of the necessary signage and after the appropriate designations on the traffic control map.
