Ordinance No. 2021-33

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN IMMEDIATE MORATORIUM ON THE CONSTRUCTION OF PONDS WITHIN THE VILLAGE CORPORATION LIMITS AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village desires to adopt an immediate moratorium on the construction of ponds, for a period of six (6) months, in order for the Village to adopt legislation regulating construction and safety standards; and,

WHEREAS, Planning & Zoning Commission has reviewed the matter and recommends the adoption of a moratorium;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That an immediate moratorium on the construction of ponds within the Village corporation limits is hereby adopted for a period of six (6) months, in order for the Village to adopt legislation regulating construction and safety standards.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
